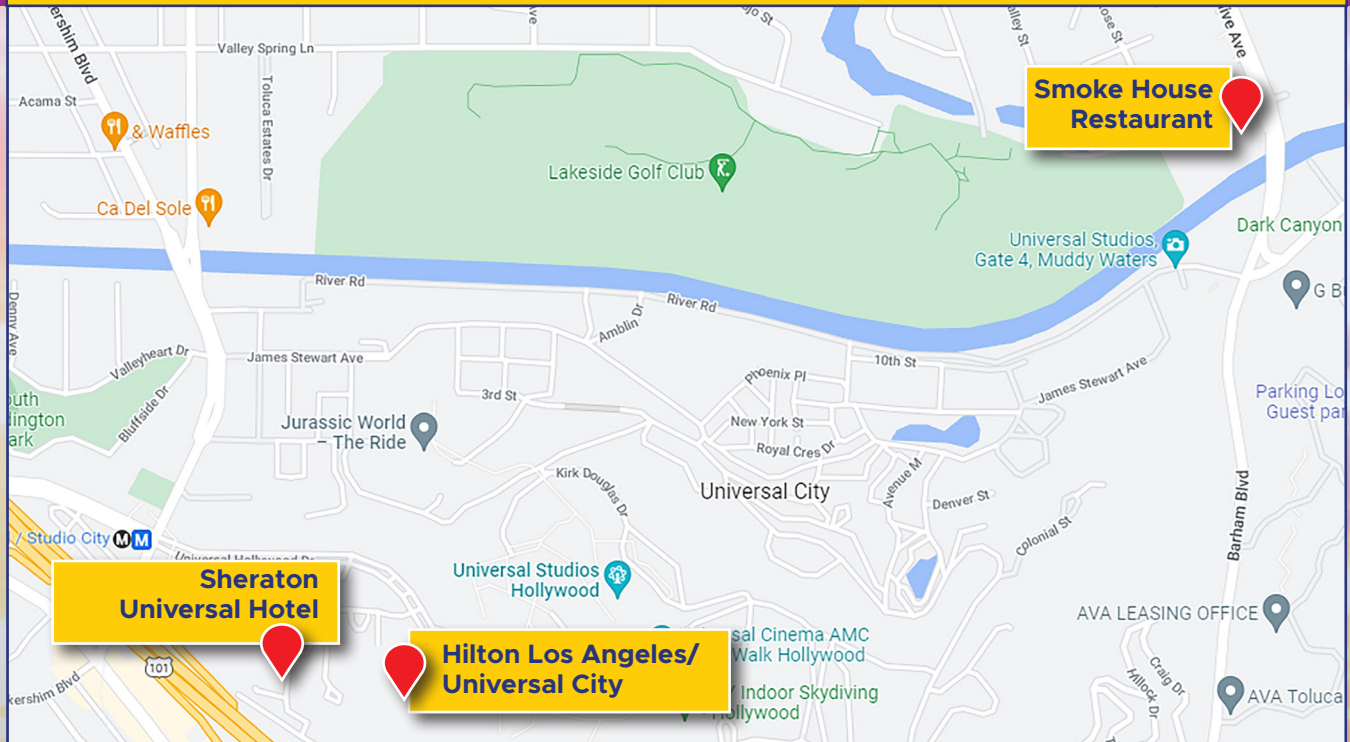
CLE CEU WHOSE RECORDING ME NOW? THE CALIFORNIA INVASION OF PRIVACY ACT
